## Take a Hike - or Ride a Bike

## **CPR Trail to the Granby Dam Site**

Easy - 1.4 km - 30 minutes one way - Heritage rail bed

Trail Info: This beautiful and accessible trail is a must in the Grand Forks area. With views of the Granby River the whole way, this trail ends with a great view of what was once the Granby Dam. This viewpoint has been updated by the GF Community Trails Society this year with a fence and an information sign that includes lots of fun facts! Keep an eye out and you might even find some little trails off of this main trail that lead to great lookouts or even beach access for a quick cool down!

There is public parking located at the trailhead. To get to this, drive 3.5 kilometres up North Fork Rd and take a right at the sign for the Boundary Motorcycle Club. Go 200m down this gravel road, please park outside of the gate and continue on foot. See 6 on map

Things to know: These hillsides can be quite dry, bring water and stay hydrated! Also be watchful for rattlesnakes and pay attention to signage. During spring months there can be many ticks so remember to do a tick check at the end of your hike.

Adventure smartly and safely!
